# WHY THE CARIBBEAN?

# The Four Caribbean Tigers, Guyana, Jamaica, Barbados and The Bahamas, are reducing government debt and growing GDP

The region has a young, growing population with low consumer debt and is transitioning from inefficiency to efficiency which creates significant investment opportunities.

- **Developing** Infrastructure (roads, ports, electricity, housing, etc.) significantly underdeveloped
- Domestic driven Jamaica has added 300,000 new investors to the local stock exchange in the last 5 years and has the lowest unemployment rate since 1962. Guyana has tripled GDP Per Capita in 3 years
- Export Opportunity Global telecommunications infrastructure has enabled the region to grow its exports of Outsourced Services similar to India but as a nearshore destination that speaks English. Guyana found oil and agricultural crops present a growth opportunity
- Capital friendly The Caribbean is private sector friendly and allows for easy convertability of US
   Dollars into Local currencies and back. The Bahamas and Barbados have currencies pegged to the USD
- Prudent Leverage Relatively low household debt and a high savings rate with reducing public sector debt

# Capitalizing On Select Trends

- Industrialization Massive growth in infrastructure and heavy industry sectors

- Education The Caribbean is a British-based education system with a highly educated population that is known to over-achieve in the USA, Canada and UK. Upskilling is required for 21st Century jobs, especially the information and knowledge sectors

  connectivity to Africa, Caribbean
  businesses have the potential to
  become Emerging Market leaders
- Scalability Global export opportunities and market access create substantial opportunities to scale as an English-speaking region in the same time zone as the US East Coast
- **Democratization of Wealth** Most of the large businesses in the Caribbean are typically owned by a few wealthy families or the government. Capital markets are developing, government-owned institutions are being privatized and family owned businesses are being listed on public exchanges. This fractionalization of businesses creates opportunities for financial intermediaries to facilitate investments by the growing middle class

# Caribbean Housing Needs

Blue Mahoe Capital Inc., will finance affordable housing across the region

Over 13 Million people in the USA are of Caribbean heritage and more than 4.5 Million are born in the Caribbean. They have no easy way to invest back home.

US, UK and Canadian investors of Caribbean hertiage want to invest back home and affordable housing in the region is a low-risk, high reward investment.

Jamaica's National Housing Trust, NHT, provides mortgages to all contributing citizens.

- Single applicant: Up to J\$9 million
   Two co-applicants: Up to J\$17 million
- Three co-applicants: Up to J\$23 million
- Special provision: If the unit costs J\$14 million or less, single applicants may access up to J\$12 million

Jamaica has **more than 70,000 NHT qualified citizens** and needs more than 100,000 housing solutions. Barbados is in need of **30,000** homes in the US\$100,000 to US\$250,000 price range and the government is willing to partner with financing partners to build more, having already delivered units. Guyana, Turks and Caicos and The Bahamas are also in desperate need of affordable housing solutions.

#### **EXPECTED OFFERING**

We will undertake a Regulation A Tier 2 offering in the USA to raise a maximum of US\$50 Million with a price of US\$10 per share and a minimum investment of US\$100 that would be open to all types of investors not just Accredited Investors and it would be valid in all US states. The majority of the capital would be used to build affordable housing across the region as well as make other impactful investments.

## **CURRENT PROJECT**

Model unit already built and team is ready to commence construction of first units for sale. Phase A of the 2BR units sold out in 24 hours and Phase B sold out in 30 minutes at the J\$17 Million price. The **1 BR** units sell for **J\$8 Million**.

#### **PENN VILLAGE**

Located in St Catherine, close to Old Harbour, Penn Village is a perfect place for families to own their home. Development of 200 Homes at an affordable price
